

DOGINHAUS RULES

Reservations

New guests must provide the following items prior to making a reservation: online registration, signed Services Agreement and Doginhaus Rules and copy of current vaccinations. After we receive this information, then we will schedule a new Meet and Greet (canines only) for introduction into our pack.

Health

- All guests must be spayed or neutered after 8 months.
- Canine guests must be current on the following vaccinations: Rabies, DHLPP, Bordatella and Canine Influenza. Feline guests must be current on the following vaccinations: Rabies, FVRCP and FeLV. *Any exemptions (due to health reasons and age) must be recommended by a veterinarian and approved by management in advance.*
- Vaccinations that have expired over 2 weeks must wait 48 hours after updating them before returning to Doginhaus.
- All puppies must be at least four (4) months in age and have completed their series of vaccinations. Puppies are required to wait one week after their final series has been given before boarding or participating in daycare.

Doginhaus will NOT accept the following:

- Guests that have had a communicable illness (or been exposed to one) during the last 30 days prior to arrival. *If a guest does receive a communicable illness (giardia, kennel cough, etc) the client must provide documentation from a veterinarian this has been resolved and in good health prior to returning.*
- Guests that require medical treatment beyond the dispensing of oral and topical medication or have drains or sutures still in place. *Guests that have had surgery in the last 30 days must be approved by management prior to arrival.*
- We do not accept dogs that do not socialize with other dogs or aggressive towards humans.

Lodging

- Doginhaus will provide clean, comfortable cots for each guest.
- Clients are responsible to bring the pet's own food. If food is not provided, then a bag will be purchased and included on the invoice upon departure.
- Doginhaus will accept personal items (food, toys, blankets, leashes, treats) these will be kept and stored in their locker and/or room. *Doginhaus cannot guarantee personal items will be returned in their original condition and are not responsible for lost items. Rawhide bones are not accepted.*
- A visual examination will be made upon arrival to check the animal's general health and overall skin conditions. If any of these are found, they will be confirmed with the owner and recorded on the guest's record.

Rates

- Rates are charged by the night. A \$15 fee will be assessed (per guest) after noon on the day of departure (canines only).
- A signed extended stay services agreement will be required for reservations three weeks or longer. (Terms and conditions apply)
- Oral and topical medications will be administered at no extra fee. *Insulin injections are not included in our services.*
